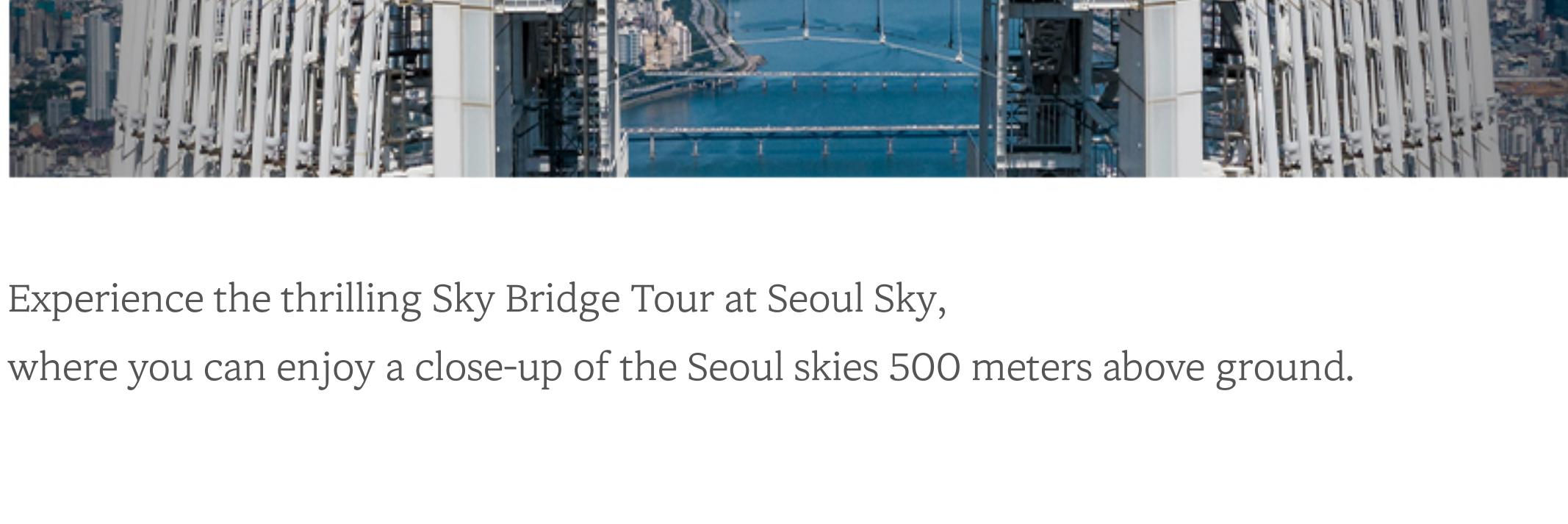

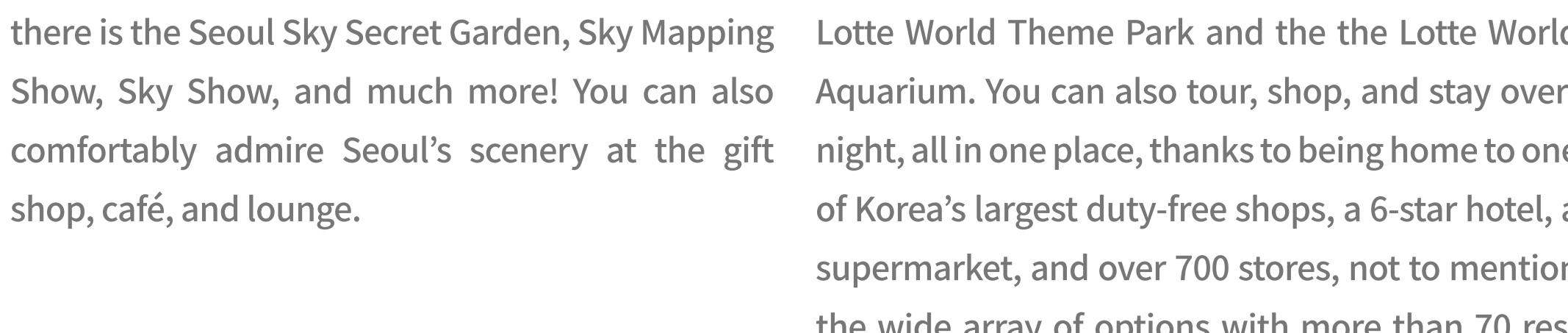
Seoul Sky is located atop Lotte World Tower, the tallest building in Korea, and with 123 floors, is the 5th tallest building in the world at 555 meters.

Experience the thrilling Sky Bridge Tour at Seoul Sky, where you can enjoy a close-up of the Seoul skies 500 meters above ground.

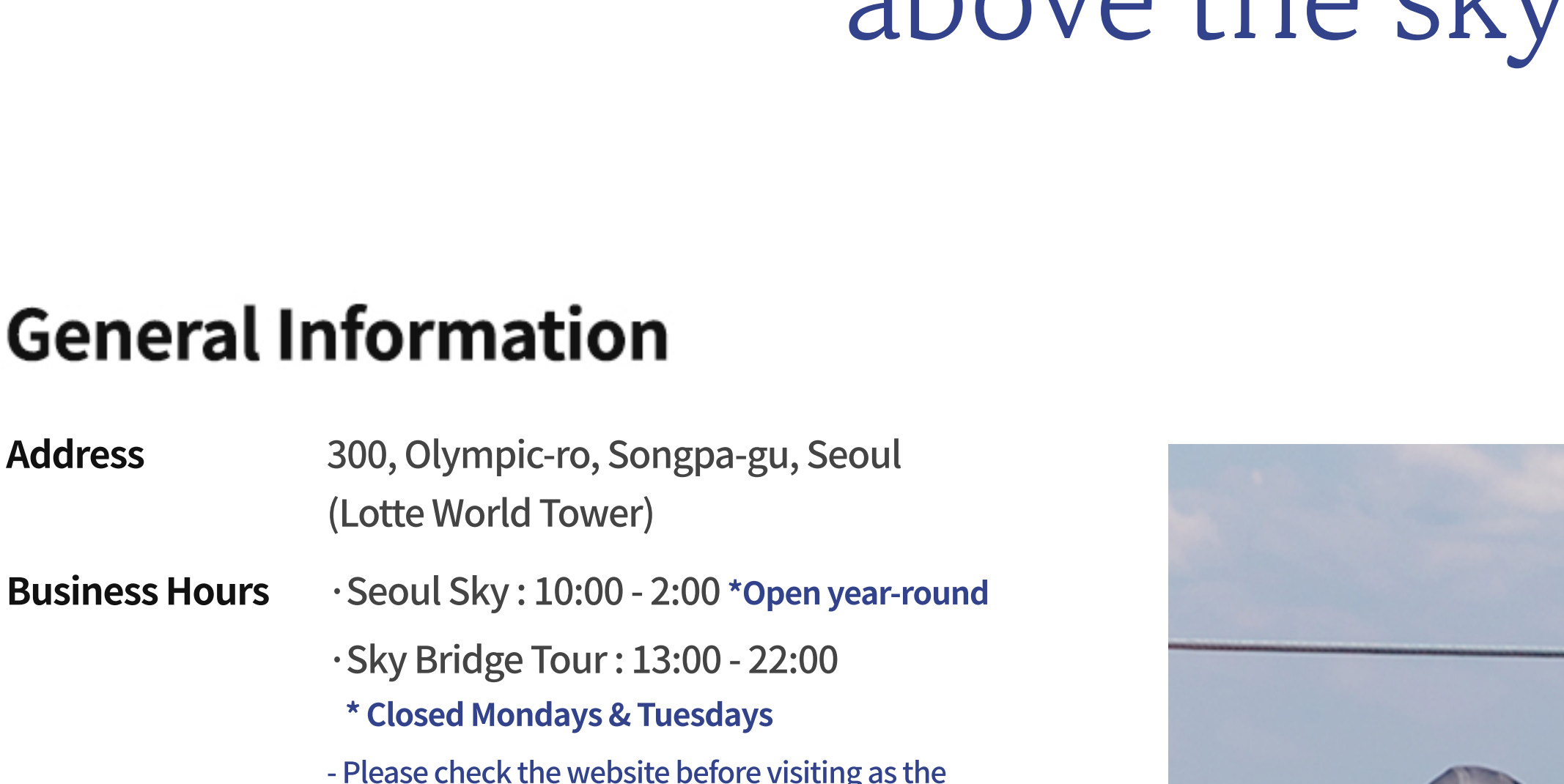
## Please Note!

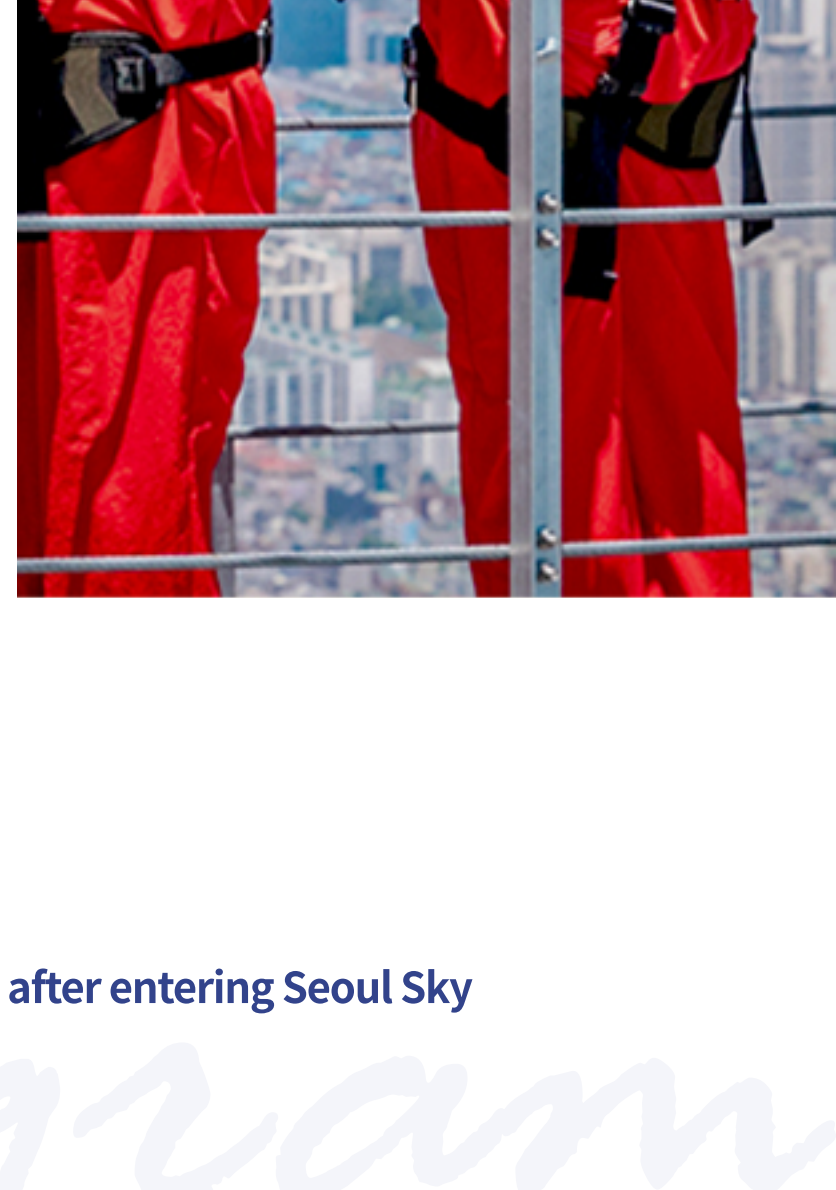

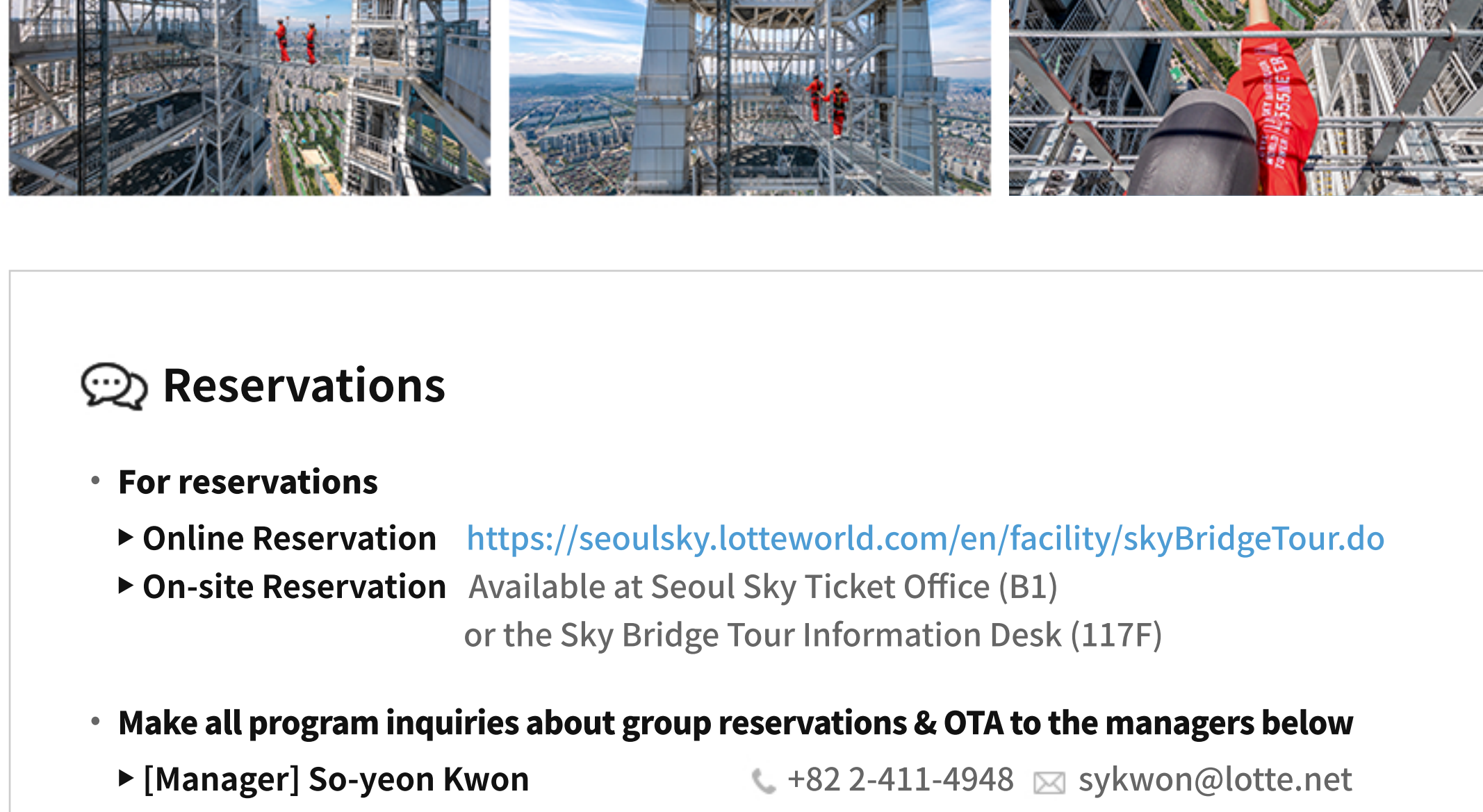

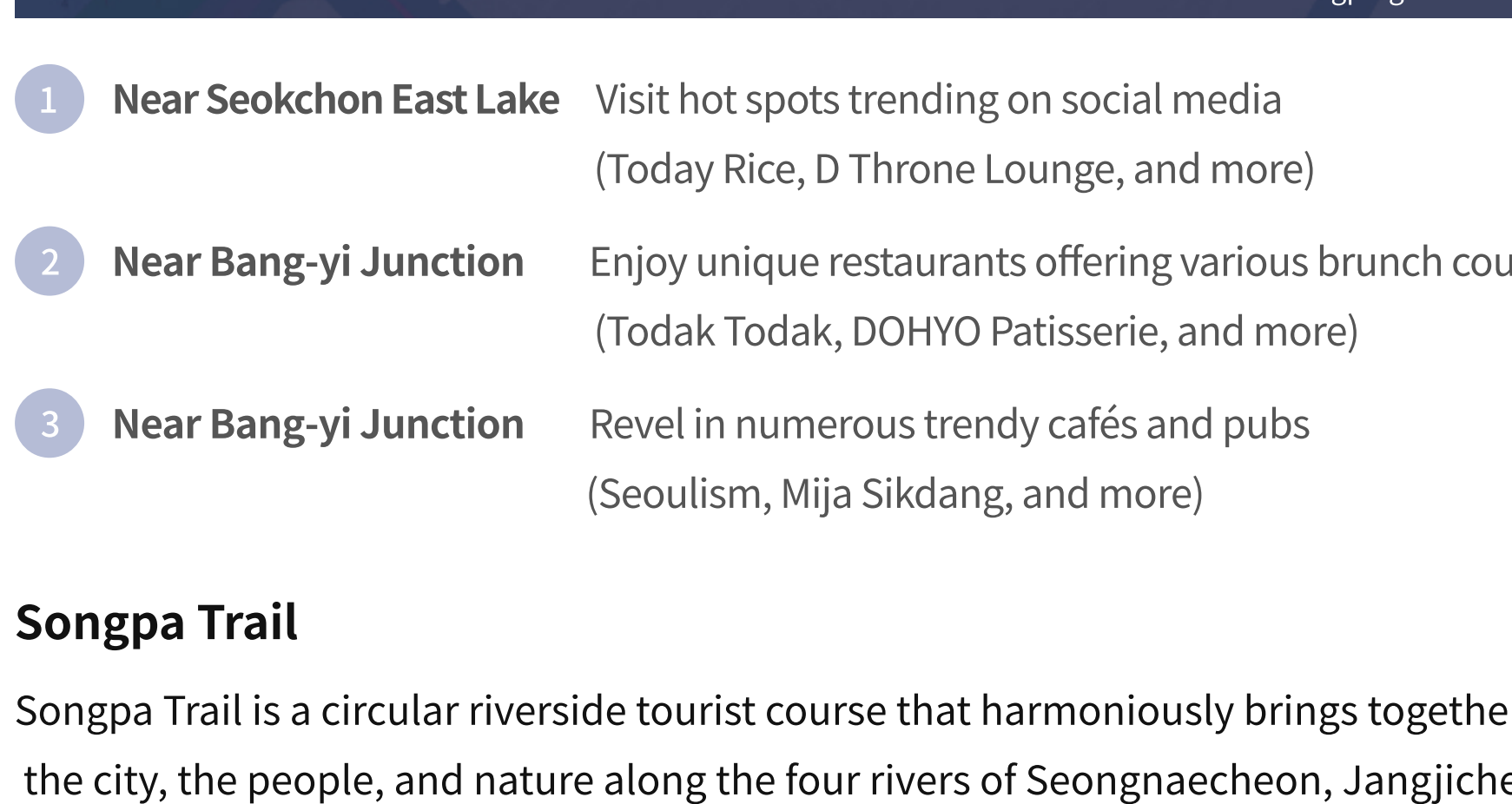

## Nearby Tourist Attractions

### SPOT. 1 ○ Songnidan-gil

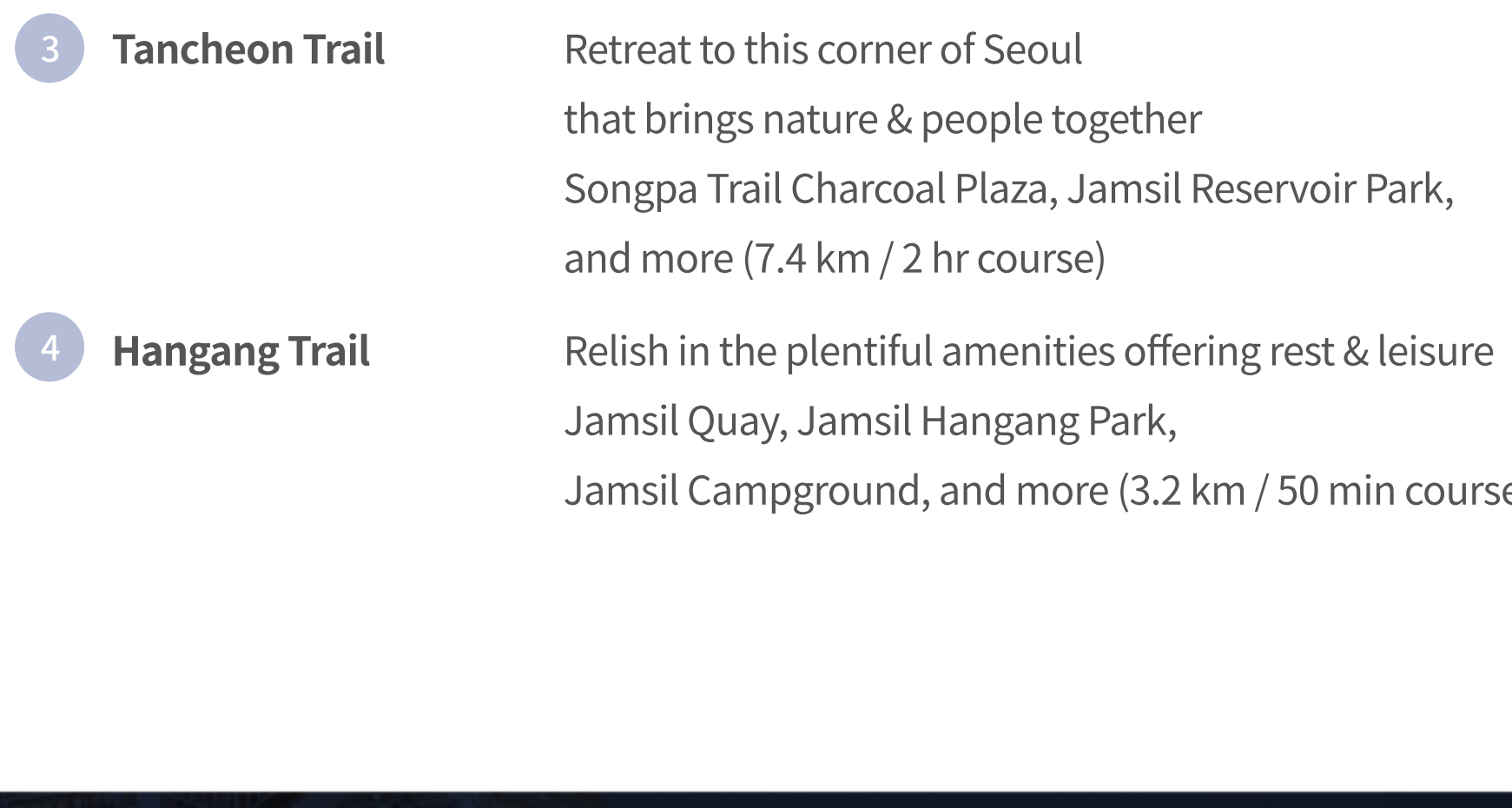
Trendy restaurants popular among the younger crowds are available in an area near Seokchon Lake Park called Songnidan-gil. Songridan-gil refers to an alleyway full of boutique cafés and unique restaurants that have opened within the past two years.



- 1 **Near Seokchon East Lake** Visit hot spots trending on social media (Today Rice, D Throne Lounge, and more)
- 2 **Near Bang-yi Junction** Enjoy unique restaurants offering various brunch courses (Todak Todak, DOHYO Patisserie, and more)
- 3 **Near Bang-yi Junction** Revel in numerous trendy cafés and pubs (Seoulism, Mija Sikdang, and more)

### SPOT. 2 ○ Songpa Trail

Songpa Trail is a circular riverside tourist course that harmoniously brings together the city, the people, and nature along the four rivers of Seongnaecheon, Jangjicheon, Tancheon, and Hangang, located in the outskirts of Songpa-gu.



- 1 **Seongnaecheon Trail** Enjoy the fusion of urban & rural scenery! Mongchon Museum of History, Rice Farming Experience Center, and more (6 km / 90 min course)
- 2 **Jangjicheon Trail** Bask in the lush, forest aroma! Jangji Park Metasequoia Road, Jangjicheon Cherry Blossom Road, and more (4.4 km / 70 min course)
- 3 **Tancheon Trail** Retreat to this corner of Seoul that brings nature & people together Songpa Trail Charcoal Plaza, Jamsil Reservoir Park, and more (7.4 km / 2 hr course)
- 4 **Hangang Trail** Relish in the plentiful amenities offering rest & leisure Jamsil Quay, Jamsil Hangang Park, Jamsil Campground, and more (3.2 km / 50 min course)
